Have the Auditor review the process and describe the flow of Tulare Local Health Care Districts' (TLHC) 2005 General Obligation Bond funds that were issued by the District to the Management company of the Tulare Regional Medical Center (TRMC), which was Healthcare Conglomerate Associates (HCCA).

How did HCCA spend the bond money?

What oversight was in place for spending the 2005 General Obligation Bonds?

Evaluate the management structures of TLHC, HCCA and TRMC.

What other problems contributed to the closure of TRMC?

What procedures or plans does the Tulare Local Health Care District have in place to reopen the TRMC?
